THE UNDER-25-FOOT MULTI-MISSION DORADO

The 240 Dorado continues Scout's versatile dual-console formula with a protected helm, deep bow seating, a flexible cockpit, an enclosed head and credible fishing equipment. Across 2022-2025, the principal dimensions, capacities, 300-hp ceiling and core standard-equipment package remain materially consistent; the meaningful changes are confined to factory-option availability.

- NuV3 fuel-efficient hull with single-outboard power
 - Full-width swim platforms with foam decking and ladder
 - Fully cushioned bow and flexible cockpit seating
- Enclosed porcelain head with nine-gallon holding tank
 - Garmin 943xs display and B60 transducer
 - Fishing, cruising and watersports equipment in one layout

MODEL-YEAR VERDICT: one website listing covers 2022-2025; no major hull, capacity or power redesign was found.
*Length note: Scout's factory flyer lists 24'4" overall; some period configuration databases retained a 23'8" hull-length figure.

- Dual-console layout with wraparound windshield and center walkthrough
- Deluxe fiberglass-back captain's chair with armrests and flip-up bolster
- Reversible port companion helm seat

- One hundred percent hand-laid fiberglass construction

- Molded non-skid deck and self-bailing cockpit layout
- One hundred-gallon fuel capacity

MODEL-YEAR OPTION NOTES

Engines, electronics, upholstery, canvas and hardtop details vary by individual factory build.
