THE MULTI-MISSION DUAL CONSOLE

For 2025, the 240 DC retains the established 25-foot hull, 8-foot-10-inch beam, 123-gallon tank and nine-person layout, but adds a factory-rated Yamaha F350 configuration. Updated literature also shifts to an engine-included weight basis and emphasizes Helm Master EX digital controls and steering.

- Seating for nine with convertible port-side lounge
 - Hideaway aft bench and deep bow lounge
 - Walk-down head with sink and Corian-style counter
- Twin 24-gallon in-floor fish boxes
 - 22-gallon livewell and dedicated tackle storage
 - Bow and stern boarding ladders with swim platform

2025 breakpoint: maximum power increases from 300 to 350 hp; F300-powered boats remain common in dealer inventory.
*Published weight basis changed: approximately 5,910 lb with engine; Yamaha listed 5,288 lb before the 642-lb F350 in its test data.

FAMILY COMFORT + SEATING

- Plush bow seating with fully recessed bow rail
- Convertible first-mate lounge with 91-quart insulated cooler
- Hideaway aft bench seating and cockpit bolsters
- Roomy walk-down head with sink and countertop
- Macerated electric head equipment available / commonly fitted
- Freshwater sinks at head and bait-prep station
- Covered stern ladder and hideaway bow boarding ladder
- Extended swim / dive platform
- USB outlets and cup holders throughout

FISHING + WATERSPORTS

- Two insulated 24-gallon in-floor fish boxes
- 22-gallon fully plumbed transom livewell
- Stainless-steel gunwale rod holders
- Hardtop rod storage on equipped boats
- Bait-prep area with freshwater sink
- Self-bailing cockpit
- Stainless through-hulls with seacocks below waterline
- Heavy-duty pull-up cleats and anchor locker
- Integrated hardtop ski-tow point on equipped boats

- Yamaha Helm Master EX digital engine controls
- Digital electric steering with compatible engine packages
- Trim tabs and trim-tab indicator

- Two-battery system on typical factory builds
- F300 remained common; F350 became factory-rated
- Garmin multifunction displays offered by factory package

CONSTRUCTION + SAFETY

- Deep-V fiberglass hull with 21.5-degree transom deadrise
- Composite, no-wood structural construction
- Foam-filled stringer grid and positive flotation design
- Self-bailing cockpit and dedicated overboard drains
- Stainless-steel hardware and pull-up cleats
- Stainless through-hulls with seacocks below waterline
- Integrated bow rail and extended swim platform
- Two-tone gelcoat pattern available across the period
- Factory specifications remain subject to build variation

- JL Audio system with amplifier and eight speakers
- Garmin GPSMAP, Airmar transducer and VHF packages
- Deluxe windlass with wireless remote
